ITMA 2023 welcomes visitors and exhibitors. ITMA Daily News reports.

ITMA has opened its doors once again, welcoming thousands of visitors and exhibitors to the 2023 edition in Milan, on 8–14 June. Owned by CEMATEX and organised by ITMA Services, the year-round association of textile manufacturers, visitors will find the event focused on "Transforming the World of Textiles". Sustainable innovations and digital advancements are key to the transformation of the industry. Challenges since the last edition have been well managed, with the Covid-19 pandemic, the energy price crisis, the energy crisis and the Russian invasion of Ukraine have all highlighted the need for a critical transformation. Additionally, the continuing geopolitical conflicts have fuelled the need for sustainable technology and the need for the future of the industry, more than ever.

These are forces that define the future of manufacturing in the textile & garment industry."

"At the same time, visitors will witness history in the making as ITMA 2023 shapes a

transformative path towards excellence," Alex Zocchi, president of ACIMIT, the host association of this edition of ITMA, said. "ITMA has consistently created high-quality events that have always been at the forefront of the industry, especially after enduring these tumultuous years of unprecedented challenges. From the pandemic to transportation issues, rising raw material costs, inflation, energy price increases, the subsequent high inflation. Nevertheless, amidst these daunting circumstances, our companies have exhibited remarkable resilience and endurance. We are pleased that the participation of 415 exhibitors has increased by 20%, 13% increase compared to the previous editions in Barcelona."


Today the ITMA Daily News brings key opinions from CEMATEX, the BTMA and ACIMIT.
