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

# ITMA announces Singapore 2025 and Hannover 2027

In the opening hours of the 19th edition of the quadrennial textile and garment technology exhibition, ITMA organizers announced the launch of an iteration of ITMA Asia in Singapore, the announcement of Hannover, Germany as the locale for ITMA 2027, and explored the effects of the Covid-19 pandemic on the industry. The world's largest textile and garment technology exhibition, ITMA 2023, opened in Milan, Italy yesterday, unveiling a definitive showcase of cutting-edge technologies presented by 1709 exhibitors from 47 countries. At the official ITMA press conference, organizers announced the show owners of ITMA ASIA + CTIME had extended their collaboration to organize the combined textile machinery exhibition in a second Asian location. The combined exhibition has been held biennially in Shanghai since 2008 but show owners CEMATEX and its Chinese partners CTMA and CCTE-lex have selected Singapore to host the exhibition in 2025. The Singapore iteration will be held at the Singapore Expo from 28-31 October 2025. Ernesto Maurea, president of ITMA.

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## ITMA Hannover 2027 announced

The opening day of ITMA Milan saw the announcement of a new iteration of ITMA Asia in Singapore, running on 28-31 October 2025. A second big announcement was the date and location of the next ITMA in four years' time: Hannover, Germany 2027 is set to take place on 16-22 September 2027.

Live from the show, we pinpoint some key innovations, such as new technology for decorticating hemp for the textile industry and its vision for the future of the market. Hemp-Act is showcasing at ITMA's first-ever Start-Up Valley.

Meanwhile, Rieter unveiled its new air-jet spinning machinery, the J 70, at an event on its booth. The company said the technology has excellent raw-material yield and low energy requirements. And, ANDRITZ announced it has acquired Dan-Web Machinery A/S based in Galten, Denmark, to take over 100% of its shares.

Also, on the Saurer booth Renewcell, Inovafil and Saurer are showcasing how a new, innovative fibre is turned into a yarn. Renewcell's circulose fibre, prepared by Inovafil for Saurer, is being spun simultaneously in three different spinning applications: air, rotor and, on selected days, also on ring.

We look forward to continuing to report from Milan over the next week.

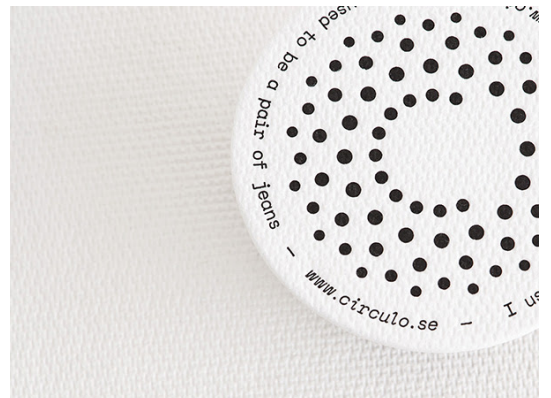

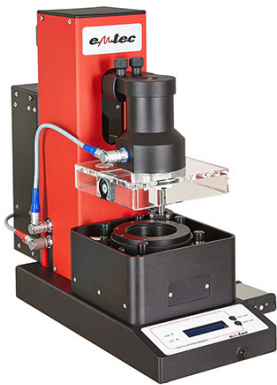
